It was written by Bill Curzon, who at the time was BBC Managing Director of Engineering, and was released as a serial in the magazine Computer Weekly, starting on December 10, 1988 and concluding on May 17, 1989. It was the last major piece of official BBC documentation to be released, as other documentation was developed internally for the BBC's Interactive Television project. The book opens with a short introduction to the BBC Micro, explaining the background to the development of the microcomputer, and the wider initiative called "MicroMagic". Chapter 1 is a description of the BBC Micro, giving the history of the system, and details about the memory and bus. Chapter 2 is a history of the early BBC Micro Computer Club, as well as the history of computing education in the United Kingdom. Chapter 3 is a history of the development of the Spectrum and Electron, which led to the development of the BBC Micro. Chapter 4 is a history of the development of software for the BBC Micro. Chapter 5 is a description of the hardware of the system, including details on the peripherals. Chapter 6 is a description of the software, starting with an overview of the Basic interpreter. Chapter 7 is a description of the Digital Peripherals, which allow the computer to talk to peripheral devices such as tape drives, printers, plotters, digital and analog inputs and outputs, and video. Chapter 8 is a description of the Time and Date package, and details on the Doctor Who software. Chapter 9 is a description of the accessories that the BBC Micro came with, and how to use the accessories. The BBC Micro: The Inside Story was shortlisted for the 1988 UK National Magazine Award in the category of the "best journalistic contribution". The shortlist was published on the cover of the magazine.
